

RESPONSE – QUESTION #13 – AEPA IFB #008 -

Yes, a list of subcontractors to be utilized in each AEPA state is required, with the applicable information listed in each of the sections referenced below to be included in the bid submittal.

BID REFERENCE:

IFB #008, Part A, IV Member Agency Specifications, 17. Oregon, Umatilla-Morrow Educational Service District (UMESD), A. Additional Agency Terms and Conditions, Instruction to Bidders, Item 5 Subcontractor Disclosure

“For public improvement contracts, all bidders shall within two hours of the date and time of the deadline when bids are due submit information about certain first-tier subcontractor when the contract value for public improvements is greater than \$100,000 (see ORS 279C.370). Specifically, when the contract amount of a first-tier subcontractor furnishing labor or labor and materials would be greater than or equal to: (i) 5% of the project bid, or \$15,000, or (ii) \$350,000 regardless of the percentage, bidders must disclose the following information about that subcontractor:

- (a) the subcontractor's name, and
- (b) the category of the work that the subcontractor would be performing, and
- (c) the dollar amount of the subcontract”

IFB 008-D, Part B, Item 3: Glossary of Terms, Page 5

“**Contractor's License:** Each of the 22 states covered by this solicitation has its own state licensing qualifications, requirements and processes. The offeror is responsible for knowing each state's requirements and codes. At the time of response, offeror must be able to comply with all licensing requirements. For those states where licenses are required a copy of the appropriate licenses authorizing the offeror to undertake or purports to undertake, supervise, subcontract others, to construct or to provide services and materials described herein, shall be included with its response. If the offeror intends to subcontract with other qualified distributors, dealers or firms, the subcontractors must be listed and copies of their licenses shall be submitted by the offeror with its response. All required licenses will be kept current and in compliance with the rules and regulations of each state's regulatory agency”

IFB 008-D, Part B, Item 4: Special Terms and Conditions, Item 4.4, Page 10.

“If the vendor intends to utilize independent agents/distributors, subcontractors and/or third-party agents to perform and/or provide any part of the products and services offered

herein the vendor must ensure that price form these parties are in accordance with the terms, conditions and pricing submitted and approved by AEPA.”

“Completed information on any subcontractor that will be utilized to provide any major components/products and/or perform services under this solicitation.”
