

RESPONSE TO QUESTION #2 – AEPA IFB #008

Historically, many tracks have failed shortly after the warranty period. Within industry literature and in accordance with the Sport Builders Association, track/tennis court life expectancy should be 5 to 10 years. AEPA is looking for quality and performance and we believe six years is the minimum end of the life cycle. Monetary investments of less than 6 years produce an unacceptable return on investment. We are requesting a minimum of six year warranty.

QUESTION #2 – AEPA IFB #008

Why is the track/tennis court warranty for 6 years in the AEPA IFB 008?
In the AEPA IFB 005 bid- you requested one year warranty on track and Atlas offered a 5 year warranty for track and a one year warranty for tennis. A 6 year track warranty exceeds the manufacturer's warranty.

Will you please consider changing the 6 year warranty to a 5 year warranty for the track portion and list a one year warranty for the tennis court surfacing?
